

Automatic Power-Off Timer

What is it?

- All current Honda models include a feature called the automatic power-off timer that's designed to switch the vehicle from ACCESSORY mode to OFF after 30 to 60 minutes of use

Why is it included?

- To help prevent the vehicle's battery from being drained

How does it work?

- With the transmission in PARK on CVT and automatic-transmission models, the timer starts when the ENGINE START/STOP button (or POWER button on hybrid models) is pushed once to engage ACCESSORY mode
- The audio system and other accessories can then be used
- If the vehicle remains in ACCESSORY mode from 30 to 60 minutes, the system will automatically switch the power to OFF
- On manual-transmission models, the steering wheel does not lock and the door locking/unlocking feature is disabled until the ENGINE START/STOP button is pushed twice

Note that:

- To fully recharge the battery after the timer has switched off the power, start the engine and drive the vehicle several miles
- Never leave children, pets or people needing assistance unattended in the vehicle
