

2018 Odyssey vs. 2017 Toyota Sienna

- Odyssey offers more dynamic, contemporary styling.
- Odyssey tops the Sienna FWD models by 1 mpg in the EPA highway rating (28 mpg vs. 27)²³



Toyota Sienna

- Odyssey comes with a multi-link rear suspension with trailing arms and a rear stabilizer bar vs. the less sophisticated twist-beam rear suspension for Sienna models.
- Sienna offers nothing like Odyssey's available Cabin-Watch™ or CabinControl™ features.
- No Sienna can be had with a feature similar to Odyssey's available hands-free access tailgate.
- Only the Sienna Limited can be equipped—at extra cost—with features similar to CMBS and ACC, standard on Odyssey EX and above trims.
- No Sienna comes with the remote engine start feature standard on Odyssey EX and above.
- Every Odyssey trim comes with a multi-angle rearview camera⁵ with guidelines that offers three viewing angles; only the Sienna Limited trim can provide more than one view—but it's limited to two.
- The HondaVAC® on Odyssey Touring and Elite models is not available on any Sienna model.
- No Sienna is available with LED headlights similar to those on Odyssey Touring and Elite trims.
- The Tire-Fill-Assist feature of every Odyssey's TPMS isn't available on any Sienna.
- Every Odyssey trim comes with a power-adjustable driver's seat; it's not available on Sienna L models.
- Every Odyssey comes with a front passenger's seat featuring 4-way power adjustment; only the top two Sienna trims have it.
- The Odyssey has more legroom in every row (40.9/40.9/38.1 in vs. 40.5/37.6/36.3).
- Odyssey offers significantly more maximum cargo volume (158.0 cu ft vs. 150.0) (non-moonroof models).²⁴

2018 Odyssey vs. 2017 Chrysler Pacifica

 The Odyssey can accommodate 8 adults standard on EX and above trims, while Pacifica makes an eighth seat optional on the four lower trims—and not available on Limited at all.



Chrysler Pacifica

- Odyssey has a 1 mpg advantage over Pacifica models without the idle-stop feature in the EPA city fuel-economy rating (19 mpg vs. 18)?³
- No Pacifica offers LED headlights similar to those found standard on Odyssey Touring and Elite.
- Pacifica's lower trims come standard with 17-inch wheels, and 18s only on the Limited trim (20-inch alloys are available on Limited—for an extra \$995); Odyssey starts with 18-inch wheels on the LX through Touring—and jumps to 19s on the Elite.
- Features similar to CMBS, LKAS and auto high-beam headlights—standard on Odyssey EX and above trims are only available on the top Pacifica trims at extra cost.
- The Tire-Fill-Assist feature of every Odyssey's TPMS isn't available on any Pacifica.
- No Pacifica can be equipped with features similar to Odyssey's available CabinTalk™ or CabinWatch™ features.
- While every Odyssey trim comes with automatic climate control, Pacifica LX and Touring trims offer only a manual system.
- HondaVAC® comes standard on Odyssey Touring and Elite models; Chrysler now offers a "Stow 'n Vac"-but only on the Limited trim.
- The Honda provides a power-adjustable front-passenger seat on all trims; Pacifica LX, Touring and Touring-L trims can't have one.
- Odyssey has more front-row headroom (40.7 in vs. 40.1), and more legroom in the second and third rows (40.9/38.1 in vs. 39.0/36.5).
- Odyssey has more cargo volume behind the third row (38.6 cu ft vs. 32.3) and a lot more maximum cargo volume (158.0 cu ft. vs. 140.5) (non-moonroof models).²⁴

2018 Odyssey vs. 2017 Kia Sedona

 Odyssey bests the highest-rated Sedona SX trim in every EPA fuel-economy category (19 city/28 highway/22 combined vs. 18/25/21)—and trounces the lowest-rated SXL (17/22/19)²³



Kia Sedona

- The Honda has more peak torque (262 lb-ft vs. 248 lb-ft).
- No Sedona offers LED headlights similar to those found standard on Odyssey Touring and Elite.
- CMBS is standard on Odyssey EX and above trims; a similar feature is an extra-cost option on Sedona LX, EX and SX, and standard only on SX Limited.
- Odyssey EX and above provide ACC, LKAS and RDM standard; nothing similar can be had on any Sedona.
- Several Odyssey trims offer a rear entertainment system to help keep rear-cabin passengers engaged; RES is only available on the Kia as a dealer-installed accessory.
- Odyssey EX-L and above models come with a power moonroof standard; it's standard only on the Sedona Limited
- Features similar to CabinControl,™ CabinTalk™ and CabinWatch,™ available on select Odyssey trims, aren't offered on any Sedona.
- Features similar to HondaVAC® on Odyssey Touring and Elite are not available on any Sedona.
- Every Odyssey trim comes with a power-adjustable driver's seat; it's not available on Sedona L models.
- All Odyssey trims are equipped with carpeted floor mats standard (2 rows on LX, all rows on EX and above); Sedona provides them only on SX and SX Limited trims.
- Odyssey has much more third-row legroom (38.1 in vs. 34.8).
- Odyssey tops Sedona in cargo volume behind the third row (38.6 cu ft vs. 33.9) as well as maximum cargo volume (158.0 cu ft vs. 142.0) (non-moonroof models).²⁴
