ADAPTIVE CRUISE CONTROL (ACC) WITH LOW SPEED FOLLOW

Helps maintain a constant vehicle speed and a set following-interval behind a vehicle detected ahead of yours and, if the detected vehicles comes to a stop, can decelerate and stop your vehicle, without you having to keep your foot on the brake or the accelerator.

How to activate the system:

Press the MAIN button on the steering wheel.

To set the vehicle speed when driving at about 25 mph or above:

Take your foot off the pedal and press down the -/SET button when you reach the desired speed. The moment you release the button, the set speed is fixed, and ACC with Low Speed Follow begins.

To set the vehicle speed when driving slower than about 25 mph:

If the vehicle is moving and the brake pedal is not

depressed, pressing the -/SET button fixes the set speed to about 25 mph regardless of the current vehicle speed. If your vehicle is stationary, you can set the vehicle speed even with the brake pedal depressed.

To switch ACC to Cruise Control:

Press and hold the 🚖 (interval) button for one second. Cruise Mode Selected appears on the driver information interface for two seconds, and then the mode switches to Cruise.

COLLISION MITIGATION BRAKING SYSTEM™ (CMBS™)

Can assist you when there is a possibility of your vehicle colliding with a vehicle or a pedestrian detected in front of yours.

The system provides visual, audible and tactile alerts of a possible collision.

To turn CMBS™ On and Off:

Press and hold the $\stackrel{\scriptstyle \bullet}{\stackrel{\scriptstyle \circ}{\to}_{\rm FF}}$ button until the beeper sounds to switch the system on or off.

WALK AWAY AUTO LOCK® Automatically locks vehicle when you walk away while carrying the remote

transmitter. Especially useful when your hands are full or if you accidentally forget to lock your vehicle.



Follow the steps in the diagram:

- 1. Exit vehicle, close all doors, then stay close and listen for a beep indicating the system is activated.
- 2. Walk at least 5 feet away.
- 3. Listen for a beep and look for the lights to flash, which confirm the doors are locked.

If you hear multiple beeps in quick succession, this is an indication that the auto lock function did not activate. Check the following:
